HOW CAMPUS PARTY IS TAKING ACTION

Rest assured, we are working very closely with our hospitality and convention facility partners to ensure both the center and exhibit hall are safe. We will continue to monitor and implement health and safety guidelines that meet or exceed CDC, state, and federal guidelines. Sponsor and campusero safety and satisfaction is our priority. Campus Party TechFest is committed to doing everything possible to provide a clean and safe experience.



Temperature checks will be
conducted before
entering the event.



Tents will be available for rent so that Campuseros will be able to experience the Campus Party 24-hour experience.

More distance between tents and wider aisles in the Tech Village will be implemented. Only Campuseros that have rented a tent will be permitted into the Tech Village after completing a health & safety screening. Hygiene stations and additional cleaning will be scheduled.



Cloth masks will be required for attendees and staff at a minimum.



Hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the event.



Indoor/outdoor spaces will be used as much as possible.



F&B will be available in a no-contact way.

Over the next 10 months, we will continue to update and modify our health & safety onsite guidelines every quarter in accordance with best practices, building rules, and local/state government regulations.

Minimal Touch Badge Pick-Up

- Each full-service station will be managed by specially trained temporary staff
- Registrants will not touch or operate Campus Party TechFest's equipment
- No outward-facing computers

Medical Screening

- Attendee and staff temperatures will be checked
- Health & Safety personnel (EMTs) will be onsite from move-in to move-out
- Campus Party TechFest will follow local health authority procedures

Mandatory Cleaning

- Regularly scheduled cleaning of TCF Center using the cleaning protocols established by ASM Global's VenueShield™. The TCF Center team is also in the process of applying for the Global Biorisk Advisory Council (GBAC) certification, providing independent, third party verification of its cleaning protocols.
- Cleaning supply kit available at registration containing disinfectant recommended by local health authority or WHO

Minimize Opportunity for Contact

- Implement digital materials when possible for safety and sustainability
- If event is not suitable for digital-only materials, handouts should be distributed via pre-stuffed show bags
- Plexiglass partitions can be added to the registration layout; contingent on availability and cost
- Stickers will be placed on floor to guide social distancing restrictions

Training Procedures

- With food and beverage industry tactics, we will train staff on proper disinfecting procedures and avoiding cross contamination
- Temporary staff will notify Campus Party TechFest when a health issue or concern has taken place and Campus Party TechFest will deal with it

Communication With Venues

- Campus Party TechFest is in constant contact with the local CVB, convention center and local government to ensure proper guidelines, plans and cleaning are implemented to go back to safely execute the event.
- Social distancing requirements will be enforced

Attendee Communication

- Campus Party TechFest will advise Campuseros on measures to keep attendees and staff safe
- May include UV sanitation stations for cell phones, masks and other PPE, alcohol swabs, etc.

Health & Safety Waivers/Questionaires

- Campus Party TechFest Campuseros and participants will be required to complete a Health & Safety waiver/questionaire during the ticket purchase process and daily Healthy & Safety Waivers/Questionaires onsite.
- Ticket purchasers will be asked to agree to additional health and safety terms & conditions prior to coming onsite to Campus Party TechFest USA.
